

<u>PATTERN</u> **1S-001**

One Skein Project: Burly Spun Hat

Designed exclusively for Brown Sheep Company by Lorna Miser

SIZE

Adult (one size)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim: 22"

MATERIALS

Brown Sheep Burly Spun, 100% wool (8 oz/132 yards),
1 skein #BS360 Autumn Journey

US Size 11 (8mm) 16" circular, and one set of double point needles

 Cable needle, stitch marker, tapestry needle, sewing needle, matching thread and one 11/4" button. (As shown, JHB Cracked Scrolls #82504.)



8 sts = 4" in Stockinette stitch

DESIGNER NOTES

The brim of this hat is knit first as a separate, complete piece before adding the crown. The stitches for the crown are picked up and knit from the top edge of the brim to the top of the hat.

STITCH GLOSSARY

Cable Edging Band (6 stitches)

Row 1: (WS): Purl. Row 2: Knit. Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: K1, slip next 2 sts to cn and hold in

front of work, k2 sts, k2 from cn, k1.

ABBREVIATIONS

CN: Cable Needle

K: Knit P: Purl

K2tog: Knit two stitches together.

St(s): Stitch(es)







INSTRUCTIONS

Brim: Cast on 6 sts. Work 23" of Cable Edging Band. Bind off. (You may pick up stitches for crown with the yarn attached to the brim if you do not cut the yarn after binding off.)

Crown: Using only ½ of an edge stitch, pick up and knit 44 sts around brim band. Place marker to mark beginning of round. Changing to double-point needles when necessary, continue in the round until hat measures 5" from the bottom edge of the brim band.

Crown Decreases:

Round 1: *K9, k2tog; repeat around. **Round 2:** *K8, k2tog; repeat around. **Round 3:** *k7, k2tog; repeat around.

Continue to work decreases every round, working 1 less stitch between decreases. When 8 stitches remain, cut yarn with 4-6" tail. With tapestry needle thread tail through all stitches. Fasten off securely and weave in ends.
