#### SIZE

One size

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

12½" x 22½"

#### YARNS

Brown Sheep Wildfoote Luxury Sock (75% washable wool, 25% nylon; 215 yd [197 m]):

Color A: Brown Sugar (SY 500)

Color B: Blue Flannel (SY28)

Color C: Blue Blood Red (SY26)

Color D: Pine Tree (SY27)

Color E: Dark Carmel (SY11)

Color F: Surfboard Blue (SY47)

one skein each.

#### HOOKS

5 mm-H/8 and 6.5 mm- K/10.5

#### NOTIONS

Tapestry needle

#### ABBREVIATIONS

sts = stitches

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

hdc = half double crochet

ch = chain stitch

sl st = slip stitch

sk = skip



#### Mesh Pattern

Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc and ch-1 space). \*Dc in next st, ch 1\*. Repeat around. End with sl st in ch 3 of beginning ch 4.

#### NOTE

This is a good project to use up leftover sock yarn. The size of the bag can be changed depending on how many repeats of the mesh pattern you choose to crochet.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

Begin at the bottom of the bag.

Using Hook H and one strand of Color A and one strand of Color B: Chain 4, join with sl st to top of first sc to form a ring.

Round 1: Work 6 sc into ring.

Round 2: Work 2 sc in each stitch around. 12 sts.

Round 3: \*Work 2 sc in first st, 1 sc in next st\* repeat.

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Round 4: \*Work 2 sc in first st, 1 sc in next two sts\* repeat.

Repeat round 4 with 1 sc in 3, 4, 5, 6 sts for a total of 8 rounds. 48 sts

Round 9: Ch 2 (counts as 1 hdc). Hdc in each sc around. Sl st in top of ch 2 to join.

Round 10: Dc in each hdc. Drop Hook H.

Using Hook K begin Mesh Pattern. You will have 48 spaces. Work one more round of mesh pattern with Colors A and B, then drop Color B and work with one strand of Color A and one strand of Color C. Work 4 rounds with Colors A and C then 4 rounds with Colors A and D and so on to desired length. Drop Hook K.

Next round: with Hook H, using 2 strands of Color F, hdc in each dc and ch 1 space around.

Next round: ch 1 (counts as 1 sc), sc in each hdc. Repeat this round 3 times.

### Handles

Continue using two strands of Color F.

Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 11 sts. Ch 2, turn. Repeat this row 7 times, decreasing 2 hdc across the last row. Work in hdc for 8 more rows, decreasing 2 hdc across the last row. Work in hdc for about 10" more. Next row, increase 2 hdc evenly across the row, work 8 more rows increasing 2 hdc across the last row. Work 7 more rows. Sk next 36 sts (from beginning row of handle) sl st end of strap to bag.

Cut yarn and weave in ends.
