## Crescent Shawl

Pattern

Designed Exclusively for Brown Sheep Company by Lorna Miser

**NEEDLES:** #9 (5.5mm) needles or size needed to get gauge

**SIZES:** One Size

**FINISHED SIZES:**

Approximately 52" wide x 10" deep

**GAUGE:** 12 sts and 24 rows = 4" on #9 needles in garter stitch

**MATERIALS:** Brown Sheep Lana Boucle 1 skein each LB 21 Rosy Rouge (A) and LB46 Sensuous Pear (B), size 9 circular needles 29" or longer to accommodate large number of stitches

**NOTES:**

Shawl begins on the inner, concave side of the curve. Short rows are worked by stopping before the end of a row, turning the work around, then slipping the first stitch and continuing across the next row. No overwrapping of stitches is needed.

**SHAWL**

**Stripe Section**

Using A, cast on 200 sts. Knit 1 row. Join B, leaving A attached.

Knit to last 5 sts, turn.

Slip 1<sup>st</sup> st, knit to last 5 sts, turn.

\*Using next color, slip 1<sup>st</sup> st, knit to 5 sts short of previous row, turn.

Slip 1<sup>st</sup> st, knit to 5 sts short of previous row, turn.

Repeat from \*, changing colors every 2 rows until 24 rows have been worked (12 ridges). Cut B. Change to color A alone and continue for 14 more rows (7 solid ridges). Cut yarn.

**Border Section**

Slip all sts from right needle to left, ready to work a RS row at the very beginning of the row.

Join B, knit all the way across every row for 12 rows (6 ridges). Cut B.

Join A. \*Bind off first 5 sts, slip next st, knit to end of row. Repeat this row 9 times. Bind off all remaining sts very loosely as this is the outer, convex portion of the crescent.

**Finishing**

Weave in ends. Block shawl.
