

DIAMOND LACE HAT

PATTERN

SIZE

Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Adult Head: 20"

MATERIALS

- BROWN SHEEP *Serendipity Tweed*, 60% Cotton/40% wool (100g/210 yds per skein) OR *Cotton Fleece*, 80% cotton/20% wool (100g/215 yds per skein): 1 skein
- US Size 7 (4.5mm) 16" double point and circular needles
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" in Diamond Lace Rib

ABBREVIATIONS

K: Knit

K2tog: Knit 2 stitches together

P: Purl

PSSO: Pass slipped stitch over just knit stitches.

Sl: Slip stitch.

SSK: Slip, slip, knit. Slip next 2 stitches knitwise individually, then insert LH needle into the fronts of these 2 stitches and knit them together from this position.

St(s) Stitches.

YO: Yarn over



STITCH GLOSSARY

Diamond Lace Rib (Multiple of 9 sts and 8 rows)

Round 1: *K2tog, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, ssk, p2; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 2 and all even rounds: *K7, p2; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 3: *K2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, p2; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 5: *K1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, p2; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 7: *K2, yo, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k2, p2; repeat from * to end of round.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using circular needles, cast on 80 stitches. Place marker for beginning of round and join, being careful not to twist.

Rounds 1, 3 and 5: Purl.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 4: Knit, increasing 10 sts evenly around. (90 stitches)

Next rounds: Work all 8 rows of Diamond Lace Rib pattern 4 times.

Shape Top of Hat

After working last round, slip last stitch worked from right needle back to left needle. This is the new beginning of round. (Move “beginning of round

Round 1: *K3tog, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, sl 1, k2tog, pssso; repeat from * to end of round. (70 sts remain.)

Round 2 and all even rounds: Knit.

Round 3: *K2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk; repeat from * to end of round. (70 sts remain.)

Round 5: *K1, ssk, k1, k2tog, k1; repeat from * to end of round. (50 sts remain.)

Round 7: *K1, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, k1; repeat from * to end of round. (30 sts remain.)

Round 9: *Sl 1, k2tog, pssso; repeat from * to end of round. (10 sts remain.)

Cut yarn 12” long. Thread tapestry needle through remaining stitches and pull gently to close. Fasten off and weave in end.
