Easy Weave Pullover

Designed Exclusively for Brown Sheep Company by Lorna Miser

Pattern

FREE

FINISHED CHEST SIZES: 38 (42, 48, 54)"

MATERIALS: Brown Sheep Lamb's Pride Worsted (85% wool, 15% mohair [190 yards/skein]) (225 (260, 300, 350) yards MC, and 1050 (1190, 1330, 1500) yards CC. Shown in MC #M03 Grey Heather and CC #M77 Blue Magic.



GAUGE: 17 sts = 4" in basketweave stitch

NEEDLES: #8 (5mm) straight needles and 16" circular, or size needed to obtain gauge.

SKILLS AND ABBREVIATIONS USED:

Carry unused yarn up side edge.

Rev stock st = reverse stockinette stitch (Purl RS, Knit WS)

K2tog: decrease right by knitting 2 together.

SSK: decrease left by slipping 1 stitch as if to knit, slipping next stitch as if to knit, place left needle through back of 2 slipped stitches and knit them together.

BASKETWEAVE PATTERN

Multiple of 6+3

Row 1 & 7 (RS): Using CC, knit

Row 2 & 8 (WS): Using CC, purl

Row 3, 4 & 6: Using MC, k4, *(sl 1, k5) repeat from *, end sl 1, k4.

Row 5: Using MC, p4, *(sl 1, p5) repeat from *, end sl 1, p4.

Row 9, 10 & 12: Using MC, k1 *(sl 1, k5) repeat from *, end sl1, k1

Row 11: Using MC, p1 *(sl1, p5) repeat from *, end sl1, p1.

BACK: Using CC, cast on 81 (93, 111, 123) sts. Work in garter stitch until there are 3 ridges on the RS, ending after a WS row. Change to basketweave pattern and work until body measures 17 (16 ½, 17, 16 ½)". Place marker at each edge for sleeve placement. Cont until entire back measures 26 (26, 27, 27)" Bind off all sts.

FRONT: Work as for back up to sleeve markers. Cont until front measures 23 (23, 24, 24)", ending after a WS row. Shape neck: work across 30 (36, 43, 49) sts, join 2nd ball of yarn and bind off center 21 (21, 25, 25) sts, work to end. Work both sides at the same time with separate balls of yarn. Dec 1 st every RS row at neck edge 5 times. 25 (31, 38, 44) sts. rem. Work even until same length as back to shoulders. Bind off all sts. Sew shoulder seams.

SLEEVE: Using MC, cast on 45 (45, 50, 54) sts. Work in stockinette, inc 1 st at each edge every 6th (4th, 4th, 4th) row 16 (18, 18, 18) times. 77 (81, 86, 90) sts. Work even until sleeve measures 21 (19 1/2, 18, 16 ½)" or desired length. Bind off all sts. Center sleeve between markers on front and back. Sew in place. Sew side and sleeve seams.

NECK: Using CC, pick up 31 (31, 35, 35) sts across back neck, approx 14 sts down left front neck, 21 (21, 25, 25) sts across front neck and approx 14 sts down left front neck. Knit every round for 1 ½". Bind off all sts loosely.
