Size

6 months (1 year, 2 year)

Finished measurements

Chest: 20 (22, 24) inches Hem to shoulder length: 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ (12, 13 $\frac{1}{2}$) inches Sleeve length: 6 (7, 8) inches Hat: 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ (17 $\frac{1}{2}$)

Materials

Brown Sheep Cotton Fleece (80% Cotton, 20% Wool [215 yards/skein]) 2 skeins MC (Shown in CW690 Alpine Lilac) 1 skein CC (Shown in CW105 Putty)

Needles

Size 6 (4mm) needles or size to obtain gauge Circular needle or dpns in same size needed for hat One dpn needed for three needle bind-off

Notions

Three ½+buttons Tapestry needle Stitch Holder, Stitch Marker Standard sewing items and thread to match MC

Gauge

20 sts and 28 rows = 4+in stockinette

Abbreviations

Sts = stitches Ssk = slip, slip knit together







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Patterns

FEATHER AND FAN Multiple of 11 Sts Rows 1 and 2: With CC, knit. Row 3: With MC, knit. Row 4: With MC, purl. Rows 5 and 7: With MC, *(k2tog) twice, (yo, k1) three times, yo, (ssk) twice; rep from * across. Rows 6 and 8: With MC, purl.

Note

Body of sweater is knit in one piece to underarms, and then divided for fronts and back. Lower body is wider than chest measurement and is decreased before dividing. Sleeves are knit flat then sewn onto body to keep the sleeve stitch pattern consistent with the body.

BODY

Using CC cast on 123 (134, 145) sts. Keeping the first and last st in garter, work in the Feather and Fan pattern until the body measures 6 (7, 8) inches from cast-on edge, ending after row 2. Cut CC.

Decrease row Continuing with MC knit across next row, decreasing 23 (24, 25) sts evenly across as follows:

6 month size: K2, (k3, k2tog) 23 times, end k6. 100 sts 1 year size: K6, (k3, k2tog) 24 times, end k8. 110 sts 2 year size: K10, (k3, k2tog) 25 times, end k10. 120 sts

Next row: Purl 25 (27, 30) sts, place on holder for left front, purl across next 50 (56, 60) sts for back, put remaining 25 (27, 30) sts on holder for right front.

Upper Back

Continue in MC on back sts only working in stockinette until back measures 4 ½ (5, 5 ½) inches. Place sts on holder for shoulders and back neck. Break yarn.

Right Upper Front

Join MC to underarm (inner edge) and purl across. Work in stockinette until upper front measures 2 inches less than the upper back piece. At neck edge, bind off 7 sts once, then 2 sts 3 times. Work even on remaining 12 (14, 17) sts until the front measures the same as back. Place sts on holder for shoulder. Break yarn.

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Left Upper Front

Join MC to underarm and continue in stockinette as for Right Upper Front reversing shaping. Place sts on holder for shoulder.

Three Needle Bind-Off/Shoulder Join

Return back sts to needle, place right front sts on a second needle. Holding front and back right sides tog work 3 needle bind-off.

Using a dpn, put needle through the first st on the front needle and then through first st on the back needle, k as usual. Repeat for second st. There are now two sts on the right needle. Lift first st over last st and off the needle. One st is now bound off. Repeat across each shoulder: 12 (14, 17) sts. Place remaining neck sts on holder.

SLEEVES

(Make two)

Using CC, cast on 57 (68, 68) sts. Keeping the first and last st in garter, work in the Feather and Fan pattern until the sleeve measures 2 ¹/₂ inches from cast-on edge, ending after row 2. Cut CC.

Decrease Row Continuing with MC knit across next row, decreasing 12 (17, 12) sts evenly across as follows:

6 month size: K4, (k2, k2tog) 12 times, end k5. 45 sts 1 year size: K7, (k1, k2tog) 18 times, end k7. 50 sts 2 year size: K7, (k2, k2tog) 13 times, end k9. 55 sts

Continue even in stockinette until sleeve measures 6 (7, 8) inches from cast-on. Bind off. Sew sleeve seam. Pin evenly into armhole and sew sleeve into body.

Left Front Edging

Using CC pick up and knit 42 (50, 58) sts from left front neck edge to cast-on edge. K three rows; bind off. Mark placement of buttons: one at last row of CC, one near neck edge and one centered between the two.

Right Front Edging

Using CC pick up and knit 42 (50, 58) sts from left front neck edge to cast-on edge. K one row. Knit next row working a % O, k2tog+buttonhole to correspond to button placement on the left front. Knit one row. Bind off.

Neck Edging

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Using CC pick up and knit 22 sts along the right front neck edge, k across the 26 (28, 26) back neck st on the holder, pick up and knit 22 sts along the left front neck edge. K 3 rows. Bind off.

Sew buttons to left front. Weave in ends. Block.

HAT

Preparing to knit in the round using circular needle or dpns and CC cast on 77 (88) sts. Join being careful not to twist sts. Place marker for the beginning of the round. Round 1: With CC, knit. Round 2: With CC, purl. Rounds 3 and 4: With MC, knit. Rounds 5 and 7: With MC, *(k2tog) twice, (yo, k1) three times, yo, (ssk) twice; rep from * across. Rounds 6 and 8: With MC, knit.

Work Rounds 1-8 three (four) times, then work Rounds 1 and 2. Cut CC. Using MC knit 1 round increasing 3 (2) sts evenly around. 80 (90) sts.

Crown Decrease Larger size only: (K7, k2tog) 10 times. 80 sts Knit 1 round

Both sizes Round 1: *(K6, k2tog); rep from *10 times. 70 sts Round 2: Knit 1 round. Round 3: *(K5, k2tog); rep from *10 times. 60 sts Round 4: Knit 1 round Round 5: *(K4, k2tog); rep from *10 times. 50 sts Round 6: Knit 1 round Round 7: *(K3, k2tog); rep from *10 times. 40 sts Round 8: Knit 1 round Round 9: *(K3, k2tog); rep from *10 times. 30 sts Round 10: Knit 1 round Round 11: *(K3, k2tog); rep from *10 times. 20 sts Round 12: Knit 1 round Round 13: *(K2tog); rep from * 10 times. 10 sts.

Cut yarn leaving an 18 inch tail. Thread tapestry needle and run through remaining sts. Fasten securely. Weave in ends.

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
