SIZE

Women's extra-small (small, medium, large, extra-large)
Instructions are given for smallest size, with larger sizes in parentheses. When only 1 number is given, it applies to all sizes.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 35 (39, 43, 47, 51)"

Length: 29 (29½, 30, 30½, 30½)"

MATERIALS

~ Brown Sheep *Lanaloft*, 100% wool (100g/160 yds per skein): 6 (7, 8, 10, 11) skeins #LL58 Festive Fall (MC)

~ Brown Sheep *Lana Bouclé*, 100% wool (100g/180 yds per hank): 2 hanks #LB101 Pumpnickel Passion

~ Size 9 (5.5mm) straight and 32+ circular needles, **or size needed to obtain gauge**

~ Size 10 (6mm) 29+circular needles

~ (9) 1 1/8+buttons JHB International #92306

~ Stitch holders

~ Stitch markers



GAUGE

16 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st with MC and smaller needles

To save time and ensure proper fit, take time to check gauge.

STITCH GLOSSARY

Ssp: Sl 2 sts separately to RH ndl knitwise, sl these 2 sts back to LH ndl. Inset RH ndl through back loops going through second st first, p2tog.

M1 (Make 1): Make a backwards loop and place on RH ndl.

~ For fully-fashioned decreases: **RS Rows:** K2, ssk, work in established pattern until 4 sts remain, k2tog, k2.

WS Rows: P2, p2tog, work in established pattern until 4 sts remain ssp, p2.

~ For fully-fashioned increases: **RS Rows:** K2, M1, work in established pattern until 2 sts remain, M1, k2.



BACK

With smaller ndls and A, cast on 61 (68, 75, 82, 89) sts. Work even in Garter St for 1+; inc 11 (12, 13, 14, 15) sts evenly on last WS row . 72 (80, 88, 96, 104) sts.

Change to St st and work even until back measures 20½+from beg, ending with a WS row.

Shape armholes

Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 2 (2, 3, 3, 3) sts at beg of following 2 rows . 62 (70, 74, 82, 88) sts.

Work fully-fashioned decs each end every row 0 (2, 0, 2, 4) times, then every other row 3 (3, 5, 5, 4) times. 56 (60, 64, 68, 72) sts.

Work even until back measures 28 (28½, 29, 29½, 29½)" from beg, ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulders

Bind off 5 (5, 6, 7, 7) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 4 (6, 6, 6, 8) sts at beg of following 2 rows.

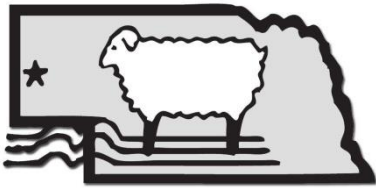
Bind off remaining 28 sts.

POCKET LININGS (make 2)

With smaller needles and MC, cast on 24 sts.

Work even in St st until lining measures 6+from beg, ending with a WS row.

Place sts on holder.

LEFT FRONT

With smaller needles and MC, cast on 29 (32, 36, 39, 43) sts.

Work Garter st as for back inc 5 (6, 6, 7, 7) sts evenly on last WS row . 34 (38, 42, 46, 50) sts.

Change to St st and work even until front measures 9+ from beg, ending with a WS row.

Join pocket linings

Work across first 5 (7, 9, 11, 13) sts of front, with RS facing, knit across 24 sts of one pocket lining, place next 24 sts of left front onto stitch holder, work to end row.

Work even until front measures 20½" from beg, ending with a WS row.

Shape armhole

Bind off at arm edge 3 (3, 4, 4, 5) sts once, then 2 (2, 3, 3, 3) sts once . 29 (33, 35, 39, 42) sts.

Work fully-fashioned decs at arm edge every row 0 (2, 0, 2, 4) times, then every other row 3 (3, 5, 5, 4) times- 26 (28, 30, 32, 34) sts rem.

Work even until front measures 26½ (27, 27½, 28, 28)" from beg, ending with a RS row.

Shape neck

Bind off at neck edge 6 sts once, then 3 sts once, and finally 2 sts once.

Dec 1 st once . 14 (16, 18, 20, 22) sts.

Shape shoulders

Bind off at arm edge 5 (5, 6, 7, 7) sts twice, then 4 (6, 6, 6, 8) sts.

POCKET EDGINGS

With RS facing, using smaller needles and MC, pick up and K 24 sts from pocket holder. Work Garter St for 1", dec 2 sts on first row- 22 sts.

Bind off.

BUTTON BAND

With RS facing, using smaller circular needle and CC, pick up and knit 107 (111, 115, 119, 119) sts along left front edge.

Work even in Garter st for 1½+.

Bind off.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for left front, reversing all shaping.

Work pocket edging as for left front.

BUTTONHOLE BAND

Work as for button band until band measures ¾" from beg.

Place markers for 9 evenly spaced buttons, having first one ¾" below top of front band, and last one ¾" above lower edge. Space remainder evenly between.

Buttonhole Row: *Knit to marker, bind off 2 sts; rep from * 8 times; knit to end of row.

Next Row: Knit, casting on 2 sts over bound-off sts of the previous row.

Work even until band measures 1½+.

Bind off all sts.

SLEEVES

Half of Turnback Cuff (make 2)

With smaller needles and CC, cast on 17 sts.

Work even in Garter st for 4+inc 3 sts evenly on last WS row . 20 sts. Do not bind off. Place sts on holder.

Join cuff halves

With RS facing and MC, knit across one half cuff, then across second half . 40 sts.

Beg with a purl row, work even in St st until sleeve measures 4+above joining row, ending with a WS row.

Continue in St st, inc 1 st each end every 4 rows 0 (0, 0, 2) times, every 6 rows 0 (0, 0, 8, 12) times, every 8 rows 0 (0, 10, 4, 0) times, every 10 rows 0 (8, 0, 0, 0) times, every 12 rows 2 (0, 0, 0, 0) times, then every 14 rows 4 (0, 0, 0, 0) times- 52 (56, 60, 64, 68) sts.

Work even until sleeve measures 18½" above joining row, ending with WS row.

Shape sleeve cap

Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Work fully-fashioned decs each end every other row 10 (11, 13, 14, 13) times, then every row 3 (4, 3, 4, 6) times- 20 sts.

Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows.

Bind off remaining 12 sts.

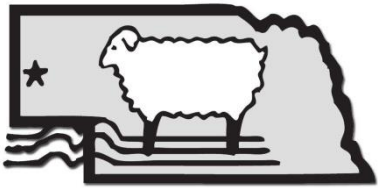
COLLAR

Sew shoulder seams.

With WS facing, using smaller needles and CC, pick up and knit 74 sts around neckline, beg and end at center of front bands.

Working in Garter st, inc 1 st each end every 4th row until collar measures 5" from beg, changing to larger needles after 2".

Bind off all sts.

ASSEMBLY

Sew pocket linings to WS of fronts. Sew ends of pocket edgings to RS of front.

Sew in sleeves. Sew sleeve and cuff seams, using MC for sleeve and CC for cuff.

Sew side seams.

Fold up cuffs and tack into place.

Sew on buttons. \hat{f}
