SIZES

Small (medium, large, extra-large and extra, extra-large. Instructions are given for smallest size, with larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

Model shown in size small.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest: 38 (43, 48, 53, 58)

Length: 23 (25, 26, 26, 28) down center back

MATERIALS

Brown Sheep Lana Boucle, 100% wool (100g/180 yds per ball)

8 (9, 10, 12, 13) balls

US Size 6 straight & double pointed, size 7 straight & 16" circular & double pointed &

size 8 36" circular

Size H crochet hook

20 (22, 22, 22, 24) inch length zipper. Separating zippers only come in 2" increments

Stitch markers and scrap yarn



GAUGE

20 stitches and 28 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

To save time and ensure a proper fit, take time to check your gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS

K: Knit

P: Purl

B&F: Knit into the back & front of the same stitch

F&B: Knit into the front & back of the same stitch

Cable cast-on: *Insert the right needle between the last two stitches. Wrap the yarn around the as if to knit & pull the yarn through to make a new stitch. Place the new stitch on the left needle. Repeat from * until desired number of stitches have been cast on.

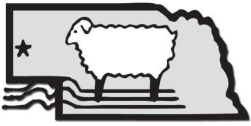
RS: Right side

WS: Wrong side

Ssk: Slip 2 stitches individually knitwise, insert left needle into these 2 stitches from left to right & knit them together.

K2tog: Knit 2 stitches together

3-Needle Bind-off: With sts on 2 needles, place RS together. K2tog (1 st from each needle) twice. *lift first st of right needle over second st (1 st bound off), knit next 2 st tog; repeat from * until desired number of stitches have been bound off.



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W&T (Wrap and turn): Bring yarn to front, slip next st from left to right needle, take yarn to back, replace st to LH needle. Turn & continue on other side. When wrapping purl sts bring yarn to back, then return to front. On following row hook wrap to WS & knit or purl with stitch.

Pm: Place marker

HOODIE POCKETS

Right Pocket

With size 7 needles cast on 19 (19, 21, 21, 21) stitches. Leave long end to sew top of pocket to hoodie

Row 1 (WS) Purl

Row 2: F&B in 1st stitch, knit to end

Repeat last 2 rows 15 (15, 18, 18, 18) more times. 32 (32, 38, 38, 38) rows all together

Continue in stockinette stich for next 18 rows

50 (50, 56, 56, 56) rows all together

With size 7 needle pick up 34 (34, 38, 38, 38) stitches along RS of sloped stitches

Turn to WS & knit one row

Pocket Band

With size 6 needles & new yarn, cast on 34 (34, 38, 38, 38) stitches. Leave a long end to sew down side of pocket.

Row 1: (RS) K2, P2. Repeat to last 2 stitches. K2

Row 2: P2, K2. Repeat to last 2 stitches. P2

Repeat last 2 rows twice more. 6 rows all together.

Place pocket & band RS together & 3-needle bind off with size 7 needle

Left Pocket

Work the same as right pocket except

Row 2: Knit to last stitch, B&F & subsequent increase rows until 32 (32, 38, 38, 38) rows all together.

Pocket Band

The same as right pocket band.

BACK

With crochet hook and scrap yarn chain 96 (108, 120, 132, 144) plus a few more

Leave a long end to 3-needle shoulder seams & with size 7 needle pick up

96 (108, 120, 132, 144) stitches along crochet chain.

Row 1: (RS) Knit

Row 2: Purl to last 6 (6, 8, 8, 8) sts. W&T

Row 3: Knit to last 6 (6, 8, 8, 8) sts. W&T

Row 4: Purl to last 12 (12, 16, 16, 16) sts. W&T

Row 5: Knit to last 12 (12, 16, 16, 16) sts. W&T

Row 6: Purl to last 18 (18, 24, 24, 24) sts. W&T

Row 7: Knit to last 18 (18, 24, 24, 24) sts. W&T



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Row 8: Purl, hooking wrapped sts to WS & purl with stitch.

Row 9: Knit, hooking wrapped sts to WS & knit with stitch.

Continue in stockinette stitch until you have 62 (66, 70, 74, 78) rows down sleeve edge.

Put stitches on stitch holder or scrap yarn

RIGHT FRONT

Pick up 24 (30, 34, 40, 46) stitches along a new crochet chain.

Row 1: (RS) Knit

Row 2: Purl to last 6 (6, 8, 8, 8) stitches, W&T

Rows 3, 5, 7 & 9: Knit to last stitch, F&B

Row 4: Purl to last 12 (12, 16, 16, 16) stitches, W&T

Row 6: Purl to last 18 (18, 24, 24, 24) stitches, W&T

Row 8: Purl, hook wraps to wrong side & purl with stitch

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: Knit to last stitch. F&B

Repeat last 2 rows 2 (2, 4, 4, 4) more times. 15 (15, 19, 19, 19) rows all together
31 (37, 43, 49, 55) stitches

Next Row: Purl in B&F of 1st stitch, purl to end

2nd Row: Knit to last stitch. F&B

Repeat last 2 rows twice, then 1st row once. 22 (22, 26, 26, 26) rows all together
38 (44, 50, 56, 62) stitches

Next row: Knit to end & cable cast on 10 stitches

Continue in stockinette stitch on these 48 (54, 60, 66, 72) stitches until you have
62 (66, 70, 74, 78) rows down armhole edge.

Put stitches on stitch holder or scrap yarn

LEFT FRONT

Pick up 24 (30, 34, 40, 46) stitches along a new crochet chain

Row 1: (WS) Purl

Row 2: Knit to last 6 (6, 8, 8, 8) stitches, W&T

Rows 3, 5, 7 & 9: Purl to last stitch, B&F

Row 4: Knit to last 12 (12, 16, 16, 16) stitches, W&T

Row 6: Knit to last 18 (18, 24, 24, 24) stitches, W&T

Row 8: Knit, hook wraps to wrong side & knit with stitch

Row 10: Knit

Row 11: Purl to last stitch B&F

Repeat last 2 rows 2 (2, 4, 4, 4) more times. 15 (15, 19, 19, 19) rows all together
31 (37, 43, 49, 55) stitches

Next Row: Knit in F&B of 1st stitch, knit to end

2nd Row: Purl to last stitch, B&F



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Repeat last 2 rows twice, then 1st row once. 22 (22, 26, 26, 26) rows all together
38 (44, 50, 56, 62) stitches

Next Row: Purl to end & cable cast on 10 stitches

Continue in stockinette stitch on these 48 (54, 60, 66, 72) stitches until you have
62 (66, 70, 74, 78) rows down armhole edge.

Joining Both Fronts & Back

Knit across left front, then knit across back & right front.

Continue in stockinette stitch on these 192 (216, 240, 264, 288) stitches until front edge measures 17 1/4 (19
1/4, 19 1/4, 19 1/4, 21 1/4) ending on a WS row

Place left pocket on top of left side of hoodie matching 1st stitches of both. Knit 2 stitches together, one from
pocket & one from hoodie. Knit to last 35 (35, 40, 40, 40) stitches & attach 2nd pocket.

Turn to WS & knit 1 row. These 2 row measure 1/4" so now the measurement down center front is 17 1/2 (19
1/2, 19 1/2, 19 1/2, 21 1/2) "

BOTTOM BAND

With size 6 needle cast on 192 (216, 240, 264, 288) stitches

Row 1: (RS) P1, *K2, P2. Repeat from *to last 3 stitches. K2, P1

Row 2: K1 *P2, K2. Repeat from * to last 3 stitches. P2, K1

Repeat last 2 rows until band measures 2 1/2"

Fold band & hoodie RS together & with size 7 needle 3-needle bind off band to hoodie, making sure front edge,
including band measures 20 (22, 22, 22, 24)"

HOOD

With size 7 needles & facing RS pick up 96 (96, 100, 100, 100) stitches evenly around neck opening.

Row 1: (WS) Purl

Row 2: K4, W&T

Rows 3, 5, 7, 9, 11 & 13: Purl

Row 4: K8, W&T

Row 6: K12, W&T

Row 8: K16, W&T

Row 10: K20, W&T

Row 12: K24, W&T

Row 14: Knit

Row 15: P4, W&T

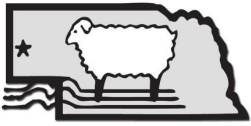
Rows 16, 18, 20, 22, 24, 26: Knit

Row 17: P8, W&T

Row 19: P12, W&T

Row 21: P16, W&T

Row 23: P20, W&T



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Row 25: P24, W&T

Continue in stockinette stitch until the number of rows at the center back is 57

Hoodie decrease

Row 1: K46 (46, 48, 48, 48) Ssk, Pm, K2tog, K46 (46, 48, 48, 48)

Rows 2 & 4: Purl

Row 3: Knit.

Repeat last 4 rows 4 more times. 20 rows all together. 86 (86, 90, 90, 90) stitches

Continue in stockinette stitch & decrease 2 stitches at the center of every row for the next 8 rows. 70 (70, 74, 74, 74) stitches.

Divide stitches evenly between two size 7 needles & fold RS together. 3-needle bind off

SLEEVES

Size 7, 16" circular needle & new yarn.

Knitted from the top down. With RS facing pick up 92 (98, 104, 110, 116) stitches around sleeve opening starting at the bottom. 3 stitches for every 4 rows. Change to double points when needed.

Rows 1 & 2: Knit

Row 3: K2tog, knit to last 2 sts. Ssk.

Repeat last 3 rows 16 (24, 24, 32, 33) more times. 51 (75, 75, 99, 102) rows

Next 3 rows: Knit

Row 4: K2tog, knit to last 2 sts. Ssk.

Repeat last 4 rows 8 (3, 4, 0, 0) more times

Knit 3 (3, 3, 3, 0) rows. 90 (94, 98, 102, 102) rows all together

Purl 1 round.

SLEEVE BAND

With size 6 DP needles

Cast on 40 (40, 44, 44, 48) stitches, dividing stitches between 3 needles.

K2, P2 around for 2 1/2 inches. Place RS of sleeve & sleeve band together & 3-needle bind off.

FRONT BAND

Size 8, 36" circular needle & new yarn

With RS facing pick up stitches starting at beginning of bottom band.

Pick up 1 stitch for every 2 rows.

Pick up edge of pocket stitches with edge of right front. Continue around edge of hood & down left front picking up stitches along edge of second pocket & down to beginning of bottom band.

Sew across top & down sides of pockets by hand.



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Hoodie With Zippered Front

Turn to WS & bind off all stitches.

Sew in zipper by hand or machine. If sewing in zipper by machine it is best to baste it in place by hand before sewing.

Hoodie Without Zippered Front

Turn to WS & knit to beginning of hood. Bind off stitches around hood & knit down 2nd side. Place both sides RS together & 3-needle bind off stitches up center front.

FINISHING

Sew in all ends & gently block
