Finished Measurements

19¹/₂" x 42" [49.5 x 106.5 cm]

Materials

Brown Sheep Company Lanaloft Sport (100% wool; 1.75 oz/50 gm, 145 yds/132.6 m): 1 skein each in LL245 Botanical Garden **A**, LL42 Sandstone Cove **B**, LL56 Blue Fir **C**, LL255 Rose Marquee **D**

US 7 [4.5 mm] 36" [90 cm] circular needle, or size needed to get gauge

Notions

tapestry needle

Gauge

21 sts and 42 rows = $4^{\prime\prime}$ [10 cm] in garter stitch.

TAKE TIME TO SAVE TIME: CHECK YOUR GAUGE!



Notes

Shawl begins at center back with Log Cabin Block. Triangle on right side works up from live stitches of final log; decreases shape the neck edge. Triangle on left side works down from top corner of central block; increases shape the neck edge. Bottom borders are added at the end by working two more log cabin logs.

Instructions

LOG CABIN BLOCK

Center Square

With A, cast on 9 sts. Knit 18 rows; bind off. Cut A; turn work clockwise 90 degrees.

Tier 1

Log 1 With RS facing and B, pick up and knit 9 sts along Center Square (1 st in each garter ridge). Knit 17 rows; bind off, leaving last st on right ndl. Turn work clockwise 90 degrees.

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Traditional & modern meet in this bold, graphic shawl! Stripes adorn the asymmetrical triangles worked from adjacent sides of a central log cabin block. Additional logs along the bottom edges unify the piece.

Pattern #1602

Log 2 With RS facing, pick up and knit 8 sts along side of Log 1 and 9 sts along Center Square—18 sts. Knit 17 rows; bind off, leaving last st on right ndl. Turn work clockwise 90 degrees.

Log 3 With RS facing, pick up and knit 8 sts along side of Log 2 and 9 sts along side of Center Square—18 sts. Knit 17 rows; bind off, leaving last st on right ndl. Turn work clockwise 90 degrees.

Log 4 With RS facing, pick up and knit 8 sts along side of Log 3, 9 sts along Center Square, and 9 sts along side of Log 1—27 sts. Knit 17 rows; bind off, leaving last st on right ndl. Cut B; turn work clockwise 90 degrees.

Tier 2

Log 5 With RS facing and C, pick up and knit 26 sts—27 sts. Knit 17 rows; bind off, leaving last st on right ndl. Turn work clockwise 90 degrees.

Log 6 With RS facing, pick up and knit 35 sts—36 sts. Knit 17 rows; bind off, leaving last st on right ndl. Turn work clockwise 90 degrees.

Log 7 With RS facing, pick up and knit 35 sts—36 sts. Knit 17 rows; bind off, leaving last st on right ndl. Turn work clockwise 90 degrees.

Log 8 With RS facing, pick up and knit 44 sts—45 sts. Knit 17 rows; bind off, leaving last st on right ndl. Cut C; turn work clockwise 90 degrees.


Tier 3


Log 9 With RS facing and D, pick up and knit 44 sts—45 sts. Knit 17 rows; bind off, leaving last st on right ndl. Turn work clockwise 90 degrees.

Log 10 With RS facing, pick up and knit 53 sts—54 sts. Knit 17 rows; bind off, leaving last st on right ndl. Turn work clockwise 90 degrees.

Log 11 With RS facing, pick up and knit 53 sts—54 sts. Knit 17 rows; bind off, leaving last st on right ndl. Turn work clockwise 90 degrees.

Log 12 With RS facing, pick up and knit 62 sts-63 sts. Knit 17 rows. Cut D.





RIGHT TRIANGLE

Row 1 (RS) With B and continuing on sts from Log 12, knit. Row 2 Knit. Row 3 Knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1-62 sts. Row 4 Knit. Row 5 Knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1-61 sts. Row 6 Knit. Rows 7-36 Rep Rows 1-6 five times—51 sts. Cut B. Rows 37-54 With A, rep Rows 1-6 three times—45 sts. Row 55 With B, knit. Row 56 and all even rows Knit. Row 57 With D, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1-44 sts. Row 59 With B, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1-43 sts. Row 61 With D, knit. Row 63 With B, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1-42 sts. Row 65 With D, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1-41 sts. Row 66 Knit. Rows 67-90 Rep Rows 55-66 twice—33 sts. Cut B and D. Row 91-108 With A, rep Rows 1-6 three times—27 sts. Cut A. Rows 109-174 With D, rep Rows 1-6 eleven times—5 sts. Row 175 Knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1-4 sts. Row 177 Knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1–3 sts Row 179 Knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1–2 sts. Bind off.



LEFT TRIANGLE

Stitches forming Left Triangle are joined with an ssk every other row to stitches picked up along side of Log Cabin Block.

With RS facing, D, and working along Log 9 side of Log Cabin Block, pick up and knit 62 sts. Cut D; slide sts to other end of ndl.

Row 1 With RS facing, B, and working at junction of Log 12 and Right Triangle, pick up and knit 2 sts.

 $Row\ 2\ (WS)\ Knit.$

Row 3 K1, ssk (joining last B st with first D st); turn—2 B, 61 D sts. **Row 4** Knit.

Row 5 K1, m1R, knit to 1 st before D sts, ssk; turn—3 B, 60 D sts. Row 6 Knit.

Rows 7-52 Rep Rows 5 and 6 23 times—26 B, 37 D sts. Cut B; join A.

Rows 53-70 Rep Rows 5 and 6 nine times—35 A, 28 D sts. Cut A; join B.

Rows 71-124 Rep Rows 5 and 6 27 times—62 B, 1 A sts.



ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit m1L = make one left m1R = make one right ndl(s) = needle(s) rep = repeat RS = right side ssk = slip, slip, knit two stitches together st(s) = stitch(es) WS = wrong side

Borders

Left Triangle Border

Cut B; join C.

Row 1 (RS) K1, m1R, knit to 1 st before D st, ssk; pick up and knit 62 sts along Log 10 side of Log Cabin Block—125 C sts.
Row 2 Knit.
Row 3 K1, m1R, knit to end—126 sts.
Row 4 Knit.
Rows 5-18 Rep Rows 3 and 4 seven times—133 sts.

Bind off, leaving last st on right ndl and leaving C attached.

Right Triangle Border

Row 1 (RS) Pick up and knit 9 sts along side of Left Triangle Border, 62 sts along side of Log Cabin Block, 1 st in each garter ridge of Right Triangle—162 sts.

Rows 2, 4, 6, and 8 Knit.

Rows 3 and 5 Knit to last st, m1L, k1-1 st increased.

Row 7 Knit.

Rows 9-18 Rep Rows 3-8 once, then Rows 3-6 once. Bind off.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block. **Y**
