## Finished Measurements

Circumference 6½" [16.5 cm]

Length 8" [20.5 cm]

## Materials

Brown Sheep Company Lanaloft Sport (100% wool; 1.75 oz/50 gm, 145 yds/132.6 m): 1 skein in LL56 Blue Fir

US 4 [3.5 mm] dpns OR 36" [90 cm] circular needle for Magic Loop method, or size needed to get gauge

## Notions

tapestry needle

stitch markers

## Gauge

28 sts and 42 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stockinette stitch

**TAKE TIME TO SAVE TIME: CHECK YOUR GAUGE!**



## Notes

*Mitts are worked in the round from cuff to fingertips.*

## Instructions

### LEFT MITT

#### Cuff

Cast on 46 sts, pm, and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist.

**Rnds 1, 3, 5, and 7** Knit.

**Rnds 2, 4, and 6** Purl.

**Rnds 8 and 9** [K3, p3] twice, k1, [p3, k3] twice, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 10 and 11** K2, [p3, k3] three times, p3, k2, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.



What better way to keep your hands toasty than with this cozy pair of diamond-patterned mitts? Texture is featured on both sides: practical rib on the palm & a decorative pattern on the back. And the cuffs are long enough to keep the chill off your wrists!

**Pattern #1604**



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**Rnds 12 and 13** K1, p3, k3, p3, k5, p3, k3, p3, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 14 and 15** [P3, k3] twice, p1, [k3, p3] twice, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 16 and 17** P2, [k3, p3] three times, k3, p3, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 18 and 19** P1, k3, p3, k3, p5, k3, p3, k3, p2, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 20-31** Rep Rnds 8-19.

### ***Thumb Opening***

**Rnd 32** [K3, p3] twice, k1, [p3, k3] twice, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to 1 st before marker, kfbf—48 sts.

**Rnd 33** [K3, p3] twice, k1, [p3, k3] twice, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to 2 sts before marker, pm, p2.

**Rnd 34** K2, [p3, k3] three times, p3, k2, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, m1R, knit to end, m1L—50 sts.

**Rnd 35** K2, [p3, k3] three times, p3, k2, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, purl to end.

**Rnd 36** K1, p3, k3, p3, k5, p3, k3, p3, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, m1R, knit to end, m1L—52 sts.

**Rnd 37** K1, p3, k3, p3, k5, p3, k3, p3, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, purl to end.

**Rnd 38** [P3, k3] twice, p1, [k3, p3] twice, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, m1R, knit to end, m1L—54 sts.

**Rnd 39** [P3, k3] twice, p1, [k3, p3] twice, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, purl to end.

**Rnd 40** P2, [k3, p3] three times, k3, p3, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, m1R, knit to end, m1L—56 sts.

**Rnd 41** P2, [k3, p3] three times, k3, p3, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, purl to end.

**Rnd 42** P1, k3, p3, k3, p5, k3, p3, k3, p2, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, m1R, knit to end, m1L—58 sts.



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**Rnd 43** P1, k3, p3, k3, p5, k3, p3, k3, p2, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, purl to end.

**Rnd 44** [K3, p3] twice, k1, [p3, k3] twice, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, m1R, knit to end, m1L—60 sts.

**Rnd 45** [K3, p3] twice, k1, [p3, k3] twice, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, sm, purl to end.

**Rnds 46-53** Rep Rnds 34-41—68 sts.

**Rnd 54** P1, k3, p3, k3, p5, k3, p3, k3, p2, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to marker, rm, bind off to end-of-round marker, leaving last st on right ndl—47 sts.

**Rnd 55** P1, k3, p3, k3, p5, k3, p3, k3, p2, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to 2 sts before marker, k2tog—46 sts.

### ***Upper Hand***

**Rnds 56 and 57** Rep Rnds 16 and 17.

**Rnds 58 and 59** Rep Rnds 14 and 15.

**Rnds 60 and 61** Rep Rnds 12 and 13.

**Rnds 62 and 63** Rep Rnds 10 and 11.

**Rnds 64 and 65** Rep Rnds 8 and 9.

**Rnds 66 and 67** Rep Rnds 18 and 19.

**Rnds 68-77** Rep Rnds 56-65.

**Rnds 78, 80, and 82** K24, ssk, knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog—44 sts.

**Rnds 79, 81, and 83** Purl.

Bind off.

### **RIGHT MITT**

Work Cuff as for Left Mitt.



### ***Thumb Opening***

**Rnd 32** [K3, p3] twice, k1, [p3, k3] twice, pm, kfbf, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end—48 sts.

**Rnd 33** [K3, p3] twice, k1, [p3, k3] twice, sm, p2, pm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 34** K2, [p3, k3] three times, p3, k2, sm, m1R, knit to marker, m1L, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end—50 sts.

**Rnd 35** K2, [p3, k3] three times, p3, k2, sm, purl to marker, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 36** K1, p3, k3, p3, k5, p3, k3, p3, k1, sm, m1R, knit to marker, m1L, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end—52 sts.

**Rnd 37** K1, p3, k3, p3, k5, p3, k3, p3, k1, sm, purl to marker, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 38** [P3, k3] twice, p1, [k3, p3] twice, sm, m1R, knit to marker, m1L, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end—54 sts.

**Rnd 39** [P3, k3] twice, p1, [k3, p3] twice, sm, purl to marker, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 40** P2, [k3, p3] three times, k3, p2, sm, m1R, knit to marker, m1L, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end—56 sts.

**Rnd 41** P2, [k3, p3] three times, k3, p2, sm, purl to marker, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.



**Rnd 42** P1, k3, p3, k3, p5, k3, p3, k3, p1, sm, m1R, knit to marker, m1L, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end—58 sts.

**Rnd 43** P1, k3, p3, k3, p5, k3, p3, k3, p1, sm, purl to marker, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 44** [K3, p3] twice, k1, [p3, k3] twice, sm, m1R, knit to marker, m1L, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end—60 sts.

**Rnd 45** [K3, p3] twice, k1, [p3, k3] twice, sm, purl to marker, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 46-53** Rep Rnds 34-41—68 sts.

**Rnd 54** P1, k3, p3, k3, p5, k3, p3, k3, p1, rm, bind off to end-of-round marker, leaving last st on right ndl, sm, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end—47 sts.

**Rnd 55** P1, k3, p3, k3, p5, k3, p3, k3, ssk, p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end—46 sts.

Work Upper Hand as for Left Mitt.

## Finishing

Weave in ends. Block mitts with the ribbing contracted to provide a snug fit. 

## ABBREVIATIONS

*dpn(s)* = double-pointed needle(s)

*k* = knit

*k2tog* = knit two stitches together

*kfbf* = knit front, back, front of same stitch

*m1L* = make one left

*m1R* = make one right

*ndl(s)* = needle(s)

*p* = purl

*pm* = place marker

*rep* = repeat

*rm* = remove marker

*rnd* = round

*RS* = right side

*sm* = slip marker

*ssk* = slip, slip, knit two stitches together

*st(s)* = stitch(es)

*WS* = wrong side
