SIZE Adult (one size)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Scarf: 4+wide by 30+long Hat: 20+circumference



MATERIALS

Brown Sheep Nature Spun Chunky, 100% wool, (155 yards/7 oz hank) 1 hank (Shown in NS522 Nervous Green)

NEEDLES

Size 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ (6.5mm) circular 16+needles and double point set or size to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

2 - 1+buttons Tapestry needle

GAUGE

11 sts & 20 rows to 4+in 2x2 ribbing

ABBREVIATIONS

Sts = stitches Tog = together SSK = slip, slip, knit these 2 stitches together Yo = yarn over

2x2 RIBBING FLAT multiple of 4 sts + 2 Row 1 (RS): K2, *p2, k2; rep from* across. Row 2 P2, *k2, p2; rep from* across

2x2 RIBBING IN THE ROUND multiple of 4 sts All rounds: *K2, p2; rep from* around.

NOTE

The brim of the hat is knit first as separate ribbing before the crown sts are picked up and knit.



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HAT

Cast on 10 sts. Work 2x2 ribbing flat for 20+. Bind off. Sew cast on and bind off ends together. Sew button over seam.

Using circular needles, pick up and knit 64 sts along one edge of hat band. Work 2x2 ribbing in the round until entire hat measures 6+from bottom edge.

Round 1 (decrease): *K2, p2tog; rep from* around.

Rounds 2-4: *K2, p1; rep from* around.

Round 5 (decrease): *K2tog, p1; rep from* around.

Rounds 6-8: *K1, p1; rep from* around.

Round 9 (decrease): *SSK; rep from* around.

Cut yarn about 18+long. Thread through tapestry needle and through remaining sts. Pull snug and finish off. Weave in ends.

SCARF

Cast on 22 sts. Work in 2x2 ribbing flat for 4+. Next RS row make buttonhole as follows: 2x2 ribbing across 10 sts, yo, p2tog, 2x2 ribbing to end of row. Continue in 2x2 ribbing until about 1 yard of yarn remains or scarf is desired length. Bind off. Weave in ends. Sew button to scarf opposite the buttonhole.
