# Lucinda Pullover

**SKILL LEVEL** ~ Intermediate

## SIZE

Small (medium, large, 1X, 2X) Instructions are given for smallest size, with larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Bust:** 35 (39, 43, 47, 51)"

**Total length:** 22 (22½, 23, 23, 23½)"

## MATERIALS

- Brown Sheep *Serendipity Tweed*, 60% cotton/40% wool (100g/210 yds per skein): 4 (5, 5, 6, 6) skeins #ST28 Bluebell
- Size 5 (3.75mm) needles
- Size 7 (4.5mm) needles **or size needed to obtain gauge**

## GAUGE

20 sts x 28 rows = 4" in St st with larger needles 17 st Lace Panel = 3"  
To save time and ensure proper fit, take time to check gauge.

## STITCH GLOSSARY

**Pm:** Place marker.

**Ssp (a left-leaning dec):** Sl 2 sts separately to RH needle as if to k, sl these 2 sts back to LH needle in this twisted position, p2tog through the back loops.

**M1 (Make 1):** Make a backwards loop and place on RH needle.

**1 x 1 Rib** (mult of 2 sts)

**All rows:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* across row.

**Lace Panel** (17 sts)

**Row 1 (RS):** P2, [ssk, yo] 3 times, k1, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, p2.

**Rows 2 and 4:** K2, p13, k2.

**Row 3:** P2, k1, [ssk, yo] twice, k3, [yo, k2tog] twice, k1, p2.

Rep Rows 1-4 for pat.

### Fully-fashioned Decreases

**RS rows:** K2, ssk, work in established pat to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

**WS rows:** P2, p2tog, work in established pat to last 4 sts ssp, p2.

### Fully-fashioned Increases

**RS rows:** K2, M1, work to last 2 sts, M1, k2.

## DESIGNER NOTE

Instructions include one selvage st each side; these sts are not reflected in final measurements.

## BACK

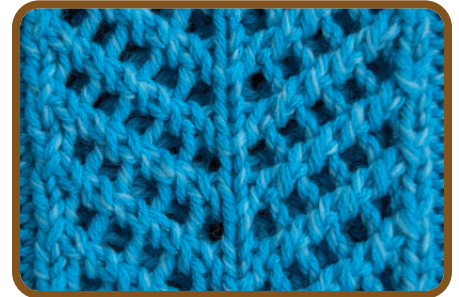
With smaller needles, cast on 96 (106, 116, 126, 136) sts.

Work even in 1 x 1 Rib until back measures 2½" from beg, inc 1 st at end of last WS row – 97 (107, 117, 127, 137) sts.

Change to larger needles.

### Set Up Pat

**Next Row (RS):** K13 (16, 19, 22, 25) sts, pm, \*work Row 1 of Lace Panel over next 17 sts, pm, k10 (12, 14, 16, 18) sts, pm; rep from \* once more,

work Row 1 of Lace Panel over next 17 sts, pm, k13 (16, 19, 22, 25) sts. Keeping sts between markers in Lace Panel as established, and remaining sts in St st, work even until back measures 14" from beg, ending with a WS row.

#### Shape armholes

Bind off 5 (6, 8, 9, 11) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 2 (2, 2, 3, 4) sts at beg of following 2 rows. Work fully-fashioned decrease (see Notes) each end every row 1 (3, 3, 3, 3) times, then every other row 4 (4, 5, 6, 6) times—73 (77, 81, 85, 89) sts.

Work even until back measures 20½ (21, 21½, 21½, 22)" from beg, ending with a WS row.

#### Shape neck

Work across 14 (16, 18, 20, 22) sts, join second ball of yarn and bind off center 45 sts, work to end of row.

Working on both sides of neck with separate balls of yarn, dec 1 st at each neck edge once—13 (15, 17, 19, 21) sts rem each side.

Work even until back measures 21 (21½, 22, 22, 22½)" from beg, ending with a WS row.

#### Shape shoulders

Bind off 3 (4, 4, 5, 5) sts at beg of next 6 rows, then 4 (3, 5, 4, 6) sts at beg of following 2 rows.

### FRONT

Work as for back until front measures 15½ (16, 16½, 16½, 17)" from beg, ending with a WS row.

#### Shape neck

Work across 28 (30, 32, 34, 36) sts, join second ball of yarn and bind off center 17 sts, work to end of row.

Working on both sides of neck with separate balls of yarn, bind off at each neck edge 5 sts once, 4 sts once, then 2 sts twice. Dec 1 st at each neck edge twice —13 (15, 17, 19, 21) sts rem each side.

Work even until front measures same as back to shoulders.

#### Shape shoulders

Bind off 3 (4, 4, 5, 5) sts at beg of next 6 rows, then 4 (3, 5, 4, 6) sts at beg of following 2 rows.

### SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on 46 (46, 50, 50, 50) sts.

Work even in 1 x 1 Rib until front measures 1" from beg, inc 1 st at end of last WS row — 47 (47, 51, 51, 51) sts.

Change to larger needles and St st. Work fully-fashioned increase (see Notes) each end every row 0 (2, 2, 8, 12) times, every other row 5 (8, 8, 5, 3) times, then every fourth row 2 (0, 0, 0, 0) times—61 (67, 71, 77, 81) sts.

Work even until sleeve measures 4" from beg, ending with a WS row.

#### Shape sleeve cap

Bind off 5 (6, 8, 9, 11) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work fully-fashioned decrease each end every fourth row 0 (0, 1, 0, 1) time, every other row 12 (13, 14, 15, 15) times, then every row 1 (2, 0, 2, 1) times—25 sts.

Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 4 rows. Bind off remaining 13 sts.

### NECKBAND

Sew left shoulder seam. With RS facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit 140 sts evenly spaced along neckline.

Work even in 1 x 1 Rib until neckband measures 1" from beg. Bind off in pat.

### ASSEMBLY

Sew right shoulder seam, including side of neckband. Sew in sleeves.

Sew sleeve and side seams.
